I want to read this book with Dad. I want to read it more. It was funny.


Ian-aged 9

Mark- No, luckily I have never been in an ambulance at all.


What do you want for a Father's Day party? Lily

Following the success of Term One's WADSA visits, they were back again this term, with even more fun activities. This time we took part in a multi sports and sensory activity session, adapted art and archery.


I wonder what they will bring next term?

After a meeting with the exiting Principal (for the day) and checking over some reports, Norman supervised the Faction Disco. Well done Principal Norman!






# **Faction Update**
